The projected income is \$47,105.00 and the estimated expenses are \$47,105.00 reflecting a balanced budget. A motion to approve the budget was made by Janis Hittle and seconded by Elaine Simon. The motion passed accepting the 2024-2025 budget.

Margaret LaVenia, Vice President, conducted the roll call of guilds. Twenty-eight guilds were represented at the meeting. For this meeting the guilds' updates and activities were tabled. Any upcoming events were shared.

Currently the organization consists of approximately 1,478 members from 39 guilds.

Grants | Cathy Parker, Grants Chair

The new Grant information and submission form for the 2024-25 NEORQC Grant Program is posted on the NEORQC website. Grants are awarded up to \$500.00 for promoting quilting in the community. The deadline for submissions is September 1, 2024.

The Getaway venue needed to be changed due to non-responsiveness and issues from the previous venue. The Getaway Committee researched and visited possible venues. The Holiday Inn Canton by Belden Village was selected and approved by the Executive Board. The dates of the Getaway had to be changed based on availability at the hotel. The new date is February 14-16, 2025. There will be a \$30 to \$40 increase to cover the increase in room rate and food. There are nine possible classes which will be reduced to five classes and open studio based on registrations. The classes and registration information will be posted on the website.
